

Big Fish School of Digital Filmmaking

Rules relating to assessment, academic credits, progression and qualification

Big Fish currently operates under the NQF guidelines, with learners submitting a portfolio of evidence (PoE) and being independently assessed as *competent* or *not yet competent*. For this purpose we use an external assessor and moderator, Portal to Learning; MAPPP SETA accredited 61450 & 58394 and ETDP SETA 115753 & 115755.

In addition to the PoE and external assessments, Big Fish sets an extra internal written and practical assessment as a means of ensuring the pace of instruction and learning is correct and to prepare learners for their external assessment and moderation.

There is no fixed percentage benchmark for passing or failing a course or module, as the NQF framework does not operate under these guidelines.

Big Fish issues a *Certificate of Completion* at the end of the course.

A formal NQF Certificate is issued by MICT Seta for those learners who are deemed competent.
